②Furusato Iiyama City History Museum

An introduction to snow country Iiyama's history and culture. Many traditional everyday tools, excavated artifacts and dioramas are exhibited here.

⑤Iiyama City Community Center

At this place you can gather for group activities, public information and learning sessions.

④Iiyama City Museum of Traditional Arts

Exhibiting art works from Iiyama, or artists associated with Iiyama. (There is a traditional industries Museum at the same site, showing the process and technique of making family Buddhist altars from Iiyama and traditional hand-made paper Uchiyama-Gami.)

⑥Iiyama Women's Center 'Mirai'

Supporting women who want to work.

③Iiyama City Library

Three story building with 'shoji screen' on the window is its landmark.

⑦Iiyama Hand-Made Paper Studio

At this place you can experience making Hand-made paper from this area 'Uchiyama-Gami' which has about 400 years of history.
